## GLOBAL MISSIONS INITIATIVES

## ILYA & JANET BANTSEEV

### Location: Eurasia

Illya & Janet are actively involved in planting church in Eurasia, serving with Europe Teen Challenge and providing continued oversight for the multicampus church planting efforts in Novokuznetsk, Siberia. Although displaced from their home due to the Russia-Ukraine war, God is using them powerfully to reach Russian-speaking people who have been displaced from their homes and have relocated throughout Eurasia.

## SERGE & NANCE BERSAGLIO

### Location: Zambia, Africa

Sergio and Nancy are the Directors of Villages of Hope - Africa (VOH-A) currently providing care to orphaned and vulnerable children in eight African locations: Burundi, Kenya, Malawi, Tanzania, Zambia (Chongwe, Kitwe, Mongu) and Zimbabwe. VOH brings "Hope for Today, Tomorrow and Eternity" by providing education, health care, feeding programs and when necessary, housing. Working very closely with national leadership, the Bersaglio' work to develop strong Christian leaders at each VOH location to ensure that the ministry is sustainable and well managed and that all children are loved and cared for and exposed to the gospel message.

The South Shore HUB is the result of a fusion of two communities very different in their identities and styles. *Oasis* was a church based in Ste-Julie that experienced great growth, then a decline during the COVID-19 pandemic. *Connexions* was a recent church founded in the Dix30 cinema. Discussions about a merger began in 2021, and a year of mutual discovery and definition of a new project led to the opening of the South Shore HUB in the summer of 2022.

• To reach the secular suburb of Montreal, existing of young professionals who have little context for faith, with the dynamic message of Christ.

### NOEL & MARNIE HUTCHINSON Location: Cambodia, Southeast Asia

The Hutchinson's work alongside Asian Outreach national staff in partnership with local churches, foundations and volunteers in Canada and the US, developing resources needed to bring transformation to at-risk communities in the region. Their primary focus is: Leadership Training, Education, Water and Sanitation, addressing food and income-security issues that perpetuate the cycles of poverty keeping families in bondage. Their goal is to work alongside national staff to see churches become the centre of the communities they work in. The Hutchinson's have been serving with Asian Outreach since 1990. They have lived in Thailand, Hong Kong and Cambodia. Noel continues to lead Asian Outreach in Canada and the US. They spend large blocks of time in Asia working directly with AO's national leaders. Their primary focus is working alongside our national staff and partners in Cambodia, Mongolia, Laos and Vietnam.

## RUSKAJANSEN

### Location: Toronto, Ontario, Canada

Ruska is an Events Coordinator with Fight for Freedom, an organization dedicated to spreading awareness on the issues and dangers of human trafficking through trainings, speaking engagements, and workshops at churches, universities, high schools and community centres. FFF journeys with over 500 individuals every month who have experienced sexual exploitation by assisting with housing, job skills, educational pursuits, life skills, case management, counselling and advocacy. Ruska is partnering with churches to minister to these men and women, with the hope of training survivors as mentors, inviting them to church and walking with them on their journey to freedom.

• Guidance to develop stronger outreach to customers of sex trafficking, and a campaign to highlight the intersectionality of human trafficking and people with disabilities.

VOH Tanzania currently provides care to over 1000 children through shelter, healthcare, and educational programs as well as another program specifically designed to cater for the needs of children and youth with albinism known as Under the Same Sun. Julius also serves as the lead pastor for Petra City Church in Mwanza, which is a newly urban church plant that seeks to transform its community by producing inspiring and equipping Christcentered believers.

• For Health and safety for their family and for continued healing and strength for Julius, as he raises his boys as a single parent.

They also taught for 16 years at EPBC/Master's College and Seminary in Peterborough, ON (1992 – 2008).

- For a healing touch from the Lord on Lynn's lung condition.



#### Location: Montreal, Canada

With almost 30 years of ministry experience, Cal and Chrissy Krahn have often been drawn to those outside of the church walls. As urban workers with Mission Canada, based in Montreal, Quebec, they care for those around them who are lonely, hurting, or in need of a friend. This can be through involvement at the local food bank, sharing a meal or a coffee with someone, connecting newcomers to Canada with helpful resources, or simply giving a granola bar to a person who's hungry. In a province where less than 1% of the population attend an evangelical service on a Sunday morning, and where many do not trust religion or have been hurt, Cal and Chrissy desire to embody "the Jesus way" by living their lives based on the example of Christ - full of generosity, hospitality and love.

## ERIC MAINSE Location: Toronto, Canada

Eric is a Satellite Director at Youth Unlimited-Waterdown, which exists to CONNECT and share Jesus with young people, through fun and attractive weekly programs that enable them to build trusted relationships. The archery program currently has 3 classes and runs on Monday evenings. The two girls clubs have about 10-15 girls each that meet on Monday and Thursday afternoons. And, around 30 students participate in the Junior High program on Friday nights. Youth Unlimited also helps students GROW in their faith through the Youth Alpha Bible study that runs on Thursdays during the lunch program. The staff SERVE about 80-110 high school students free food, Tuesday to Friday each week, and they also provide opportunities for youth to SERVE in the community as well!

Prayer Request:

• For guidance and support to create new programs with staff, and to be able to send more students to local youth groups.

### NORTHWIND FAMILY MINISTRIES

### Location: First Nations, Canada

If you had met Bera and Benita (founders of NorthWind) twenty-five years ago, when they lived in an isolated First Nation's community in British Columbia, or fifteen years ago while serving at Eagle's Nest Ministry Centre in northern Alberta, or five years ago at Eagle's Cove near Thunder Bay, Ontario, you would have heard a common thread. They longed to welcome Canadian Indigenous families, hurting from emotional wounds and trauma, into a safe environment where they could find hope in Christ and experience whole-life discipleship.

## ORNAMENTS OF GRACE & VIRTUE

### Location: Nigeria

OGAV work with public schools in low-income communities to bring about the transformative power of education where lack of essential skills and financial support has led to poor choices. Character Education empowers the girls to develop good morals and life values that are taught through the Scriptures. Career exploration encourages the girls to develop their potential to gain entrepreneurial skills for financial independence which has a positive effect on the family. OGAV endeavours to bring about financial and economic inclusion that encourages sustainability and continuity in the family and the community. Since a significant number girls are known to stay at home during their menstruation due to lack of feminine hygiene products, OGAV's holistic approach to girl-child education embraces the WHO Initiative – "Ending Menstrual Poverty" – equipping girls with reusable sanitary pads to ensure regular school attendance.

## DAVE SAWLER Location: Nova Scotia, Canada

Pastor Dave Sawler is based in Glace Bay, Nova Scotia, Canada where he pastors Lifehouse Church. Alongside his wife, Shirley, they began ministering to the community around them who faced food insecurities. Providing brunch and lunch programs for the kids who had no place to go during the summer. Food hampers are distributed a few times a week and they have done more than 35,000 meals for those in their community.





We are dedicated to seeing many new churches started here in Cape Breton, along with several more centers for youth.

## JEFFREY & AKIKO SONNENBERG

### Location: Toda, Japan

Jeffery and Akiko are focused on serving as catalysts to help encourage multiplication in Japanese churches. They are involved in coaching and encouraging church planters on the local, regional and national level. Jeffery is also involved in supporting leadership development focused on Japanese pastors and church planters. Jeffery is actively involved in researching the churches of the disaster areas of north eastern Japan following the triple disasters of 2011. The lessons learned by the churches after the disaster are helpful and relevant for church planters and Christians across Japan.


## JEFF & RACHEL

In the past, this training has taken the form of a traditional Bible college. Now their focus is expanding to include those who want to start businesses among the unreached and unengaged — teaching principles of Business for Transformation (B4T). As their business grows and gains influence, their opportunity to spread the message of Jesus grows with it. The goal is one and the same as traditional work: win the lost, make disciples, and establish new churches. It is to that end that they labour.

Prayer Requests:

- For more education, humanitarian aid, people with entrepreneurial skills and developmental skills, and for the building of a spiritual life.
- That God would continue to grow the persecuted church.

### Location: Restricted Access Nation

As Associate Executive Director of Mission Global and Executive Director of RAN, Jeff and Sarah serve global workers who are committed to "making Christ-followers among the Least-Reached and Most Vulnerable peoples of the world, especially where the message is restricted." They particularly give leadership in the areas of Strategy, Mobilization and Operations, working with Regional Directors and Global Workers to see God's kingdom advance in places Christ is not yet known. They are encouraged by what God is doing, and yet there are still whole people groups for whom the gospel is restricted. It is their privilege and challenge to lead a team in taking the gospel to these neglected peoples.

Prayer Requests:

- Need more workers to devote their life to these hard to reach places.
- For wisdom as we lead our global workers under Christ.

## MATT & ERICA

### Location: Restricted Access Nation

Matt and Erica have seen God establish and build His church in North Africa. This included seeing a local missional business (B4T) start and facilitate the gospel. Among other ministry advancements, this model of ministry has recorded the New and Old Testament in the heart language of the people, written and published worship music and developed or translated many other discipleship and evangelistic tools, including ALPHA. The ministry is well on its way to being self -sufficient and through this model they are confident the area will continue to be pastored by the local business owner. With this confidence, they are transitioning to engage another frontier people group in a majority Muslim nation in Asia. The people group in focus is 99.9% Muslim and face many barriers to hearing and learning about the gospel, including legal access to scriptures. Matt & Erica will also serve into their RAN Business Incubator, joining a small team of people training global workers and national partners to establish God honouring businesses to replicate what they saw happen in North Africa.

## CHRISTIANS AGAINST POVERTY

### Location: Ontario, Canada

John Kirkby started Christians Against Poverty in 1996. He believed God was calling him to sacrifice his career in finance and use his knowledge of the industry to help those in need. Through our dedicated team and through hundreds of incredible churches delivering our services, people in desperate need are discovering life-changing freedom and hope every day. Since 2013, we've seen hundreds of families and individuals break free from debt and poverty. And as the impact of the cost-of-living crisis is felt in households across Canada, there is much more to be done.

## CHURCH IN REGENT PARK

### Location: GTA, Canada

The church originally began in 1995 to serve the people of Toronto's downtown core. It was then known as Cornerstone Urban Church, a partner church of Church in the City. Cornerstone began a dinner program to feed the hungry and offer a place to belong in a safe community. Today Cornerstone Dinners feed about 400 people weekly, almost entirely with volunteers. As Regent Park continues to be revitalized, many desire to have a church to call their own. Church in Regent Park officially re-started Easter 2016.





What was once a 4-day breakfast program has multiplied and become a 365-day facility that houses a Thrift Store and Food Bank.






